

**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH OOS/7/10 AT THE WELLS, SHEPPERDINE ROAD, OLDBURY ON SEVERN)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION
ORDER 2021

The above order, made on 2 June 2021, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that part of public footpath OOS/7/10 running from the unaffected part of OOS 7 at Point A (grid reference ST 6190 9582) north of The Wells and running in a south south easterly direction across an open field for a distance of 177 metres to the field boundary to the rear of The Wells, then continuing through the garden, skirting around the property and outbuildings, and continuing along the driveway in a generally south easterly direction for a distance of 90 metres to Point B (grid reference ST 6195 9555) where the path meets the Shepperdine Road, shown by a bold continuous line marked A - B on the order map to a line running from the said Point A and running in a south south westerly direction across the open field for a distance of 114 metres to a field boundary at Point C (grid reference ST 6186 9571) north-west of The Wells and then continuing in a south westerly direction across another field for a distance of 71 metres to Point D (grid reference ST 6180 9567) where the path meets the Shepperdine Road -having a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked A - C - D on the order map.

Any representation about or objection to the order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services at the undermentioned address quoting reference L3/STOR/PT.6683 not later than 19 July 2021. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, South Gloucestershire District Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
