It is an ideal venue for meetings, presentations, social events and a host of other activities.

The Main Hall



The Main Hall can seat up to 72 people, or be used by up to 100 people for events. It has a lovely light and airy look.

The building is fitted with energy efficient central heating and double-glazed windows, which keep the hall nice and warm during the winter months.

A presentation system with large pull down screen, microphone, PA system and hearing loop are available in the Main Hall on request. Wi-fi is also available.

Stage blocks can be provided if required.

The piano is old but in good working order.



From the main hall, the doors at the rear lead to kitchen on the right.

The rear door on the left, takes you into the Lobby.

The Kitchen



The kitchen has recently been refurbished with smart cream gloss units, ample shelving and LED lighting. Crockery and cutlery is available as well as tea pots, kettles and an urn. There is a microwave and a modern double electric oven. The commercial dishwasher washes glasses and crockery in 90-180 seconds! There is also an under-counter fridge with small freezer box, a double sink, under-sink water heater, for instant hot water and a separate hand wash basin.

The kitchen can also be accessed from outside via the entrance door off the pathway, which runs along the right hand side of the hall.

The Lobby



Doors to the rear of the Lobby, lead to the smart new gents and ladies/disabled toilets situated on the left and the Meetings Room/ storage area on the right.

Tables and some spare chairs are kept in the Lobby area, along with the film club equipment unit, a spare extension lead with floor cover to prevent trip hazards and the wi-fi router.

The Meetings Room



The Meetings Room is set up with a long trestle table and chairs. A white board is available for use, if required.

It is suitable for meetings up to 12 people and can be accessed via the rear side entrance, at the far end of the pathway, to the right of the hall.

Spare chairs and card tables are also stored in this area.
